Lodging: We have arranged for attendees to stay together as a group during this course. It is an intense learning experience, and the companionship of colleagues to both study and play during the off-hours is always a bonus.

Attendees will stay in one of two condo units at The River Club (www.theriverclub.com), and the course will take place in the great room of one of the two units. A lodging fee of \$600 secures your spot in the 'residential only' condo. We will hold the course in the 2nd condo living room (and kitchen) during daytime hours, sharing the cost with three of you and minimizing our presence after hours; for \$450, you can reserve one of the rooms in this course location condo. Either lodging fee covers your housing for 7 nights - arriving on **Sunday, April 21, 2019**, and departing on **Sunday morning, April 28, 2019**.

Parking is limited at the Condo and in town. We recommend that you fly into Montrose, CO and ride the Telluride Express shuttle to and from Telluride (best to book that in advance).
